








Welcome Home Ministries

Our tenth and eleventh recovery residences were Christmas presents for eight men in December 2023. These two residences (photo above) have a total of four apartments with two bedrooms in each apartment (eight additional recovery beds) for graduates of our entry level congregate living recovery program. These wonderful gifts were made possible, because of the generosity of an "Angel Investor" who purchased the properties with the understanding that in September 2024, WHM will purchase these properties from the "Angel Investor."

There is no doubt that we will achieve this important goal through faith in God, that He will provide — as He has done for nearly 32 years of ministry at Welcome Home Ministries — through the faithful financial support of our many friends and supporters. We anticipate serving approximately 250 men in eleven recovery residences in 2024.

These hurdles often include physical, or mental health conditions, a criminal history, no driver's license, and low skills development... It is one thing to offer "supportive housing;" it is another thing altogether to provide Recovery Houses that are "safe, healthy, family-like substance free living environments that support individuals in recovery from addiction." (Best Practices for Recovery Housing — Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration). Welcome Home Ministries provides an alcohol and drug recovery support ministry that encourages participants to reach long-term sobriety, self-sustainability, spiritual wholeness, and improved physical and mental health...
